

## The Human Cost of Vision Loss

Compared to people who are sighted, people with blindness, deafblindness or low vision experience:

- Two to five times as much difficulty with daily living.
- Twice as much social dependence.
- Greater difficulty in reading medication labels.
- Twice the risk of falls.
- **Four** times the risk of serious hip fractures.
- Premature admission to nursing homes - three years earlier on average.
